Sinking in quicksand, he screamed for help. A philosopher walked past and developed a theory about sinking and fear. Another walked past and thought that this should be a lesson to everyone. Still sinking, another person walked past and thought he would be happy later in heaven. Another walked past and thought he would be reincarnated later in another form. Then Jesus walked by, reached out and pulled the man out.

One difference between Jesus and other religions is that Jesus gets stuck in. Gets stuck in to the social and political problems of the day – and pays a price. Many other religions have beautiful philosophies, but the founder doesn't get stuck in to the problems of the day – and pay a price. Jesus uses his own life and body and willingly pays the price.

The price he pays, of course is the cross. How many other founders of world religions die a broken, wounded, naked, bleeding, barbaric and gruesome death on a cross? Or something equivalent? You couldn't make it up! It's almost absurd - it just has to be true. This Jesus is our Christian hero. This is why we have crucifixes in our homes, and on our bodies — as Jesus saves the man in the quicksand, so he is saving us, if, of course, we are a people of real faith. Not superstition. That is the real power of the cross to save. That Jesus the Christ is totally with us.

When we look at other world contributions we see Jesus' teaching far surpasses all of the greatest world philosophers. Jesus painted no pictures, yet the greatest artists of all received their illumination from him. He wrote no poetry, yet the greatest poets were inspired by him. He composed no music, yet the greatest classical music reached their highest perfection - all in his honour.

Who is this Jesus for us? Many looked for a warrior, he came as Peace – they missed him. Many looked for a king, he came as Servant – they missed him. They looked for political liberation, yet he died on a Roman cross – they missed him. They looked for someone to fit their own ideas – he was the idea-breaker - they missed him. Must we miss him too?

And Jesus challenges us: "who do you say I am?"

ISOLATED DUE TO CORONAVIRUS - HOW TO OBTAIN HELP

The source of your support depends on which category of 'shielding' you fall into. **Category 1** - you have been contacted by the NHS and told to remain at home for 12 weeks. You are being supported directly from the government. If you were not contacted by the NHS and told this then you do not fall into this category.

Category 2 - anyone over the age of 70, plus anyone under the age of 70 with certain serious health conditions plus pregnant women - you are being supported by Essex County Council through their Essex Welfare Service. Please contact them on 0300 303 9988.

Category 3 - Everyone else.

You are supported by the **new helpline** set up by Rochford District Council in partnership with local faith groups, churches and voluntary organisations. If you have no friends or family close by and you need support during this crisis, or are feeling isolated, please call **01268 779999**.



READINGS AT MASS – 21st SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

First reading – Isaiah 22:19-23

I place the key of the House of David on my servant's shoulder

Thus says the Lord of Hosts to Shebna, the master of the palace: I dismiss you from your office, I remove you from your post, and the same day I call on my servant Eliakim son of Hilkiah. I invest him with your robe, gird him with your sash, entrust him with your authority; and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the House of Judah. I place the key of the House of David on his shoulder; should he open, no one shall close, should he close, no one shall open. I drive him like a peg into a firm place; he will become a throne of glory for his father's house.

Gospel - Matthew 16:13-20

You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church

When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi he put this question to his disciples, 'Who do people say the Son of Man is?' And they said, 'Some say he is John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.' 'But you,' he said 'who do you say I am?' Then Simon Peter spoke up, 'You are the Christ,' he said, 'the Son of the living God.' Jesus replied, 'Simon son of Jonah, you are a happy man! Because it was not flesh and blood that revealed this to you but my Father in heaven. So I now say to you: You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church. And the gates of the underworld can never hold out against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven: whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth shall be considered loosed in heaven.' Then he gave the disciples strict orders not to tell anyone that he was the Christ.
