5th March 2023 2nd Sunday of Lent A Psalter Week 2

The bus rattled and bumped along the road. A frail elderly man sat holding a bunch of flowers. Just across from him sat a young girl whose gaze was fixed on the flowers. Just as the man was about to get off the bus, noticing the girl's gaze, he impulsively but calmly thrust the flowers into the girl's arms. "I can see you like these flowers", he said gently. "Yes, they're incredibly beautiful," she replied, "thank you so much". "I'm sure my wife would like you to have them", he smiled. I'll tell her I gave them to you. I know she'll be delighted". Graciously accepting the flowers, the girl watched the frail man get off the bus and hobble into the cemetery.....

Everything is gift. To do what he did, I suspect this man had had a "transfiguration" experience somewhere in his life. Maybe his wife did too. For him all was gift which he simply wanted to share. We all need this to re-appreciate the goodness, beauty and truth in our world. But when?

Sometimes, when we least expect it, God opens the eye of our soul so as we can briefly glimpse the divine within and around us. Anywhere. Anytime. In Tescos? Why not? In the kitchen? Why not? Holding a sleeping baby? Why not? With your pet? Why not? Some might say that it wasn't Jesus so much who was transfigured, but the disciples. In a moment of time, they saw beyond physical appearances to a life, truth and beauty that is already there. They saw Jesus as the eternal Christ, the Christ who always was, is, and will be, existing beyond time. Maybe, like beauty, to an extent, transfiguration is in the eye of the beholder.

Transfiguration is not a Hollywood special effect, but a glimpse of heaven when we are not expecting it, maybe when our guards are down. Sometimes last thing at night, maybe first thing in the morning as we are waking up. Notice in the Gospel, the disciples were very tired when they had the Transfiguration experience. In these precious moments, our minds are not racing away with thinking, ruminating, worrying and planning, so we are more open to a reality beyond. We realise that there is more to heaven and earth than meets the eye, and we can feel like the disciples and want to say "it is good to be here". It is the opening of the everyday heart and mind to the heaven that is already here. An authentic Transfiguration experience changes us forever.
